RESOLUTION 78, 2024: APPROVAL OF ACQUISITION OF AN EASEMENT BY THE MONROE COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO §1096(6-a) OF NEW YORK’S PUBLIC AUTHORITIES LAW

WHEREAS, The Monroe County Water Authority (“Authority”) intends to provide public water service to 11054 South Lake Road located in the Town of Pavilion; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of the easement is necessary for operation, maintenance and the future replacement of the water main which will allow the Authority to continue to reliably provide potable water supply to the area; and

WHEREAS, the easement is located along the frontage of 11054 South Lake Road (Tax Acct. No. 016-1-6.1 which is owned by Michael R. Campbell and Ann Campbell and

WHEREAS, §1096(6-a) of New York’s Public Authorities Law requires the Authority to obtain the prior approval of the Town Board for the above-referenced acquisition; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Town hereby approves of the Authority’s acquisition of the frontage easement located at 11054 South Lake Road in accordance with §1096(6-a) of the New York Public Authorities Law and be it further

RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be provided to the Authority.

RESOLUTION 79, 2024: HOME RULE REQUEST IN SUPPORT AND REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF SHARED COURT FACILITY BETWEEN TOWN OF PAVILION,

GENESEEE COUNTY, NEW YORK with TOWN OF COVINGTON, WYOMING COUNTY, NEW YORK; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pavilion, Genesee County, currently leases space for its' Justice Court at the Town of LeRoy, Genesee County; and

WHEREAS, each Town is and has been responsible for their own Justices, Court Clerk, office equipment and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pavilion pays an annual fee of \$6,000.00 to the Town of LeRoy; and

WHEREAS, the Town of LeRoy has requested an increase for the lease in the amount of \$6,000.00 for a total of an annual fee of \$12,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town of LeRoy is located approximately ten (10) miles from the Town of Pavilion; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Covington, Wyoming County is contiguous to the Town of Pavilion and is located approximately three (3) miles from the Town of Pavilion, Genesee County; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Covington, Wyoming County has offered and agreed to share its' court facilities with the Town of Pavilion for an annual fee of \$6,000.00; and

WHEREAS, moving the Court facility from the Town of LeRoy to the Town of Covington would be a cost savings for residents of the Town of Pavilion and in addition, would be closer in proximity to the Town of Pavilion; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Town of Pavilion, Genesee County be allowed to share and hold Justice Court in the Town of Covington, Wyoming County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk of the Town of Pavilion be directed to provide certified copies of this resolution to Governor Hochul.
